Announcing Hair Auditions

OK, so the hills are currently alive... but beyond those hills, what is on ETC's horizon? It's a trip back to the 60's to revisit the original rock musical – HAIR!

Hair is a rock musical with a book and lyrics by James Rado and Gerome Ragni and music by Galt MacDermot. A product of the hippie counter-culture and sexual revolution of the 1960s, several of its songs became anthems of the anti-Vietnam War peace movement. At the time, the musical's depiction of the use of illegal drugs, sexuality, profanity, its irreverence for the American flag, and its nude scene caused much comment and controversy.

The musical broke new ground in musical theatre by defining the genre of the "rock musical" by utilising a racially-integrated cast and inviting the audience onstage for a "Be-in" finale. After an off-Broadway debut in October 1967, the production opened on Broadway in April 1968 and ran for 1,750 performances, followed by a successful London run of 1,998 performances.

The musical tells the story of the "Tribe", a group of politically active, long-haired "Hippies of the Age of Aquarius" fighting against conscription to the Vietnam War and living a bohemian life together in New York City. They struggle to balance their young lives, loves and the sexual revolution with their pacifist rebellion against the war and the conservative impulses of their parents and society.

Risk-taking is essential for this show, so take this into consideration when choosing your audition material. All performers must be able to move well and MUST be over 18 years of age.
