LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!

Some of the biggest films in history - from *Grease* to *The Sound* of *Music* - started out life as a stage musical.

But last weekend a brand new local production of a much-loved stage musical started out its life as a film.

The attempt to merge film into a live action production had its beginnings in Prince's Square last Sunday when Daniel Priest (aka Captain von Trapp) filmed the hippy tribe enjoying life to the fullest.

Tasdance's Cindy Foster has taught the cast difficult dance moves and lifts that most of them never dreamed of achieving, and then added jugglers, acrobats, circus performers and fire twirlers to complete Encore's vision of a celebration of life.

According to *Hair* director, Jamie Hillard, "I want the opening sequences of the show to have a breadth in the Annexe Theatre that only something like film can achieve, and show the cast taking in the best that life offers – freedom, peace and happiness. And to achieve this feeling, what better setting than one of Launceston's magnificent parks? So, with Daniel's help we are creating a 2-3 minute piece of film that will serve as the opening section of the show, and then in the theatre have the performers appear live on stage to take over from their celluloid-selves."

"When *Hair* first premiered people were looking for change. There was an unpopular president, an unnecessary war... it's not difficult to see resonances between the story of *Hair* and Australia and the world's past 12 months with the peoples' desire for change. I believe audiences will embrace the chance the revisit the Age of Aquarius with us."

Phenomenal musical numbers include Aquarius, Good Morning Starshine. I Believe in Love. Hair and Let the Sunshine In.

Brimming with energy, passion and the music that rocked the world, *Hair* is an entertaining and powerful tribute to the turbulent spirit of the 60's.
