## The (Piano) Keys to Buy Locally...



Since forming in April 2008, Launceston's Encore Theatre Company has faced many challenges to mount their community theatre productions, begging and borrowing costumes, set pieces, props and even instruments.

However, one ongoing need has been for keyboards, essential to the rehearsal and performance process. And that need has now been fulfilled by a grant from the Tasmanian Community Fund.

And with those grant funds in hand, Encore have chosen to support local business and make those purchases of two Kurzweil keyboards (totalling \$5,390) through Barratts Music. From the printing of posters and programs, theatre, sound and lighting hire costs, wherever feasible the team choose to spend their show budgets locally in support of local businesses and employment.

Danny Gibson, The Examiner's Promotions and Special Projects Manager says "The Examiner is delighted that Encore has embraced the Buy Locally Campaign and we congratulate them on securing the community grant. Spending locally, whether on a theatre ticket or a new keyboard supports our community and does make a difference."


