Relive the Age of Aquarius

Hair is the summer musical that has Launcestonians buzzing with excitement and opened last week at the Annexe Theatre, Inveresk.

With a score including such enduring musical numbers as *Aquarius*, *Good Morning Starshine*, *Hair* and *Let the Sunshine In*, the production depicts the birth of a cultural movement in the 60's and 70's that changed the world forever.

Hair follows a group of hopeful, free-spirited young people who advocate a lifestyle of pacifism and free-love in a society riddled with intolerance and brutality during the Vietnam War. As they explore sexual identity, challenge racism, experiment with drugs and burn draft cards, the "tribe" in Hair creates an irresistible message of hope that continues to resonate with audiences 40 years later.
