Launceston City Council has recognised the tireless efforts of Team Encore by awarding the company with the Outstanding Volunteer Achievement Award 2011 in the field of Arts, Culture and Heritage.

Run entirely by volunteers, in 2010 Encore presented 4 shows bringing together the artistic, technical and administrative talents of approximately 160 cast members, 80 crew, 40 musicians and 120 theatre ushers. From actors to singers, musicians to make-up artists, carpenters to electricians, scenic artists to seamstresses, each played a significant role in delivering Encore's community productions, with a conservative estimate of total volunteer hours in 2010 at 40,000+.

Volunteering anything from 10 to 400+ hours to raise these events which entertained a collective audience of 14,500+ people, according to box office data some 40% of these audiences came from 15kms or more away from the City of Launceston, bringing with them economic benefits as they enjoyed these shows in the central city where there is shopping, food and entertainment facilities also available.

Delivering affordable, locally produced shows to the wider community, Encore firmly believe that theatre is the greatest team sport ever invented, where individuals can only shine because of the work and dedication of the team supporting them.




MAKEUP FOR THEATRE
