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

Broadway's longest-running American musical, Chicago is a dazzling and satirical look at fame, justice, and the media machine. Set in 1920s Chicago and based on real-life murders and trials, Chicago follows Roxie Hart, a wannabe vaudevillian star who murders her lover and is arrested, despite her attempts to convince her pushover husband, Amos, to lie for her. In the Cook County Jail, Roxie meets her hero, the famed double-murderess and nightclub performer, Velma Kelly. When both acquire Chicago's slickest lawyer, Billy Flynn, tensions come to a head as they vie for the spotlight. Neither woman will be outdone in their fight against each other and the public for fame and celebrity.







ABBEY HANSSON

Born to perform, whether dancing, singing, or acting, Abbey has lived on stage ever since she could walk.

Her first taste of musical theatre was with Encore Theatre Company's *Grease*. This was just the beginning – whether performing in *Annie, The Phantom of the Opera*, the Mistress in *Evita*, Elle Woods in *Legally Blonde*, Maggie in *A Chorus Line* and Kathy Seldon in *Singin' In The Rain*, there has been no stopping her.

On the big screen, he has worked in the film industry with Hugh Jackman, Kylie Minogue, Jean-Claude Van Damme and the late Raul Julia and on various Australian TV series and commercials.

MARCELLO LO RICCO SOUND DESIGNER



This is Marcello's 15th production with Encore.






JASON BOVAIRD LIGHTING DESIGNER

Sydney-born Anthony Phillips worked in professional theatre for over 40 years, holding positions of wardrobe supervisor with The Old Tote, Sydney Theatre Company, Australian Opera and freelancing before setting up Anthony Phillips Costumes to work on the original build of *The Phantom of the Opera*, encompassing some 25 years of South African and Asian Tour cast changes on that life-changing production.

Anthony was head cutter on two Star Wars films (Episode 2 and 3), and his company provided costumes for many memorable productions including 42nd Street, Anything Goes, Les Misérables, Miss Saigon, Chicago, Mary Poppins, King Kong, Priscilla and many productions for Bell Shakespeare. He has tutored at NIDA and TAFE and was acknowledged by winning the lifetime achievers award by the APDG.

Closing his company after the build of *Matilda* and seeking retirement and a quieter life in Launceston, Encore invited him to design and make a range of principal costumes for their production of *Les Misérables, The Sound of Music, Strictly Ballroom* and *We Will Rock You*, for which he won Outstanding Costume Design (Musical Theatre) at the 2020 Tasmanian Theatre Awards.

In 2021 he created the principal costumes and the iconic ABBA costumes for Encore's *Mamma Mia!* and then executed the corsetry for the John X Presents season of *The Rocky Horror Show*.



SONIA JAGER COSTUME MANAGER

Sonia has enjoyed a long association with community theatre, from behind-the-scenes roles involving costumes, set building and painting, to front of house manager and booking office. 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
