Who is the Academy for?

The Encore Theatre Company Academy has been created to promote and teach all areas of Musical Theatre.

This includes Dance, Singing, Acting, Technical Theatre and Orchestral Pit work. Opportunities will be given to students to learn from and be mentored by leading local, national and international professionals.

We are committed to inclusiveness and creating a safe space for any student interested in Musical Theatre and all components of production.

Terms 1 and 4 will be focussed on workshops and skill building. Terms 2 and 3 we will turn our focus to the annual production, where all members of the Academy will be involved.

Junior and Middle Company

Through our workshop program, we will guide students in the art of theatre and enable them to discover a new world of performing and creativity in a safe and fun environment. Students will learn the basics of stagecraft that will help equip them for future performances. Particular focus will be given to the three main areas of Musical Theatre -Singing, Acting and Dancing.

Our classes will also focus on developing social skills and self-confidence for all our students.

Senior Company

Our Senior Company will be given opportunities to extend themselves. Through workshops with professionals, audition technique and performance opportunities students will be able to hone their craft.

Each week they will work with a professional in their chosen field and be given the opportunity to develop their technical skills off stage.

Students will also be given the opportunity to learn direction skills (both dramatically and musically), should this be of interest to them.
